### **CLINICAL PRACTICE SUMMARY**

For over 25 years I have been a practicing physician specializing in XX. My particular interests have focused on a-b-c. My current practice, which is part of the physician group at the University of YY, has grown over time from a small panel of patients primarily from the local community into a large panel of approximately zz patients drawn from the local area, the rest of the state and at least three contiguous states. I have developed a reputation as a thoughtful, knowledgeable expert in the identification and treatment of ww, an elusive syndrome which often poses significant diagnostic challenges to physicians; as a result, a large portion of my practice is now comprised of referrals from colleagues seeking a definitive diagnosis for patients presenting with ambiguous symptoms. I place high priority on quality of care within my own practice and have become very involved in quality assurance issues on the institutional level; I have also been called upon to direct my quality of care expertise towards policy development at the local and national levels, as reflected in the administrative leadership section.

On at least a bi-annual basis, through the XX Society, I provide pro bono clinical care – more generic in nature than my regular practice – to impoverished populations. In nearly a decade with this program I have participated in six medical missions to Africa and Central America.
