# FACULTY COUNCIL MEETING NOTES March 14, 2018

#### i. Introductory Remarks

• <u>Welcome</u> -- Dr. Choudhri thanked the council for attending and welcomed Dean Charney for his annual update.

### 1. Faculty Wellness – Jonathan Ripp, MD, MPH

- Burnout close to 50% among physicians.
- Response rates were 35.2% (4,402/12,500) for medical students, 22.5% (1,701/7,560) for residents/fellows, and 26.7% (7,288/27,276) for EC physicians.
- Many factors causing burnout, including hours, work/life balance, efficiency and resources, workload demands, meaning in work, etc.
- Consequences include suicide, depression, substance abuse, and also workplace issues such as decreased quality of care and physician turnover.
- Mindfulness meditation can help alleviate burnout.
- ACGME requirements dictate that institutions increase attention to work intensity and compression as well as provide more tools and resources to assist physicians.
- Projected cost of physician turnover per year due to burnout: \$36.8 million
- Goals for ISMMS include creating a protocol for responding to tragic events and developing a Center for Wellness similar to the student wellness center.
- Suggestions from FC: faculty dining room, improved parking, more accessible child care
  options, faculty gym.
- FC Wellness Committee to be established.
- More engagement with Wellness Officer.
