*The Robin Chemers Neustein Postdoctoral Fellowship is intended to encourage and support female research scientists at ISMMS. The award was established in 2010 through a generous gift from Robin Chemers Neustein, a former member of Mount Sinai's Boards of Trustees, and a tireless supporter of women's career advancement in science and other disciplines.*

### Eligibility Requirements

**The awardee must:**

- Be a senior female postdoctoral scientist, currently working at ISMMS
- Have demonstrated high-impact accomplishments in the biomedical sciences, as well as have the potential for an independent scientific career
- Intend to complete her postdoctoral training within two years

### Nomination Materials

**Applications will be accepted at any time before the due date. They must be submitted in PDF format to Theresa Scarabino and must include the following:**

- Candidate's curriculum vitae
- Candidate's statement of general research interest (maximum 1 page)
- Sponsoring Scientist's NIH Biosketch
- Title and Statement of Research Project for the next 1-2 years (maximum 2 pages, including title of project and references)
- Up to four (4) publications
- Two letters of recommendation (one from the Sponsoring Scientist, commenting on how the candidate's research is interdisciplinary, novel, elegant and high impact, as well as the candidate's potential for an independent career in science)
