The MPH degree requires the completion of 45 total credits, through coursework, an Applied Practice Experience, and a Culminating Experience. This track has 32-33 defined credits. Remaining credits are accrued through electives, seminars and independent study. The Academic Program Office and Track Advisor should be consulted early to plan ahead for the completion of the MPH degree requirements.
