



Goals and objectives for the 4 week rotation emphasize cardiopulmonary physiology and pathophysiology, anesthetic considerations and perioperative management of patients with cardiac surgical disease, the principles and practice of invasive hemodynamic monitoring, and basics of transesophageal echocardiography. A current textbook of cardiac anesthesia is available for use during the rotation and a large amount of interactive teaching will go on in conjunction with patient care in the OR. Students are expected to prepare for their assigned cases, to assist with all routine aspects of anesthesia care and to participate in our divisional weekly didactic teaching conference. Opportunities for performance of procedures in appropriate patients (e.g., insertion of intravenous and intra-arterial catheters, endotracheal intubation, central venous access) will depend on the level of experience of the student.
