Customer Instructions:

1. Any and all clutter must be removed for technician(s) to properly access all areas needing inspection and/or treatment prior to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd service visits. This includes (boxes, paper cans, posters, clothing, shoes, safes, etc.)
2. Remove all linens, clothing, personal items and all materials from the following areas:
A. Beds (must be completely accessible to tech). **B.** Couches, sofas, chairs, recliners, etc. **C.** Dressers, bureaus. **D.** Night stands, end tables. **E.** Shelving. **F.** Closets, cabinets. **G.** Drapes, blinds, curtains, etc.
3. Any and all picture frames and removable hanging objects should be taken off wall prior to each of the 3 visits. These items will be inspected and treated. Some items can be damaged from treatment. The trained technician will use judgment and your approval prior to treating these items.
4. Prior to initial treatment all carpeting, flooring, books, electrical appliances and any other items that cannot be laundered should be vacuumed. **Carpeting should be pulled 6 inches from wall around any room that is carpeted.
5. Prior to initial treatment all outlet, light switch, and phone jack covers should be carefully removed for tech to treat. During treatment the technician will drill holes approximately every 18 to 24 inches to apply a dust pesticide into wall voids.
6. Protect-A-Bed, bed bug proof mattress and box spring encasements should be purchased and installed before the 1st treatment is performed.
7. All clothing linens towels and similar items must be laundered in water above 120 degrees Fahrenheit and dried on high heat. Items must be sealed in plastic bags after they are laundered.

1. Any foreign travelers (meaning non-resident of apartment or house being treated) bringing baggage, luggage, etc. into the apartment presents the possibility of re-infestation.
2. Any and all new furniture purchased should be inspected by a pest management professional or K9 before it enters the apartment.

HUMANS AND ALL ANIMALS CANNOT ENTER THE AREA BEING TREATED FOR A MINIMUM OF 2 HOURS AFTER EACH TREATMENT.

Be advised that:

Bed bugs can be found in mattress folds, seams and comforters and can easily spread to window/door frames and casings, pictures, posters, loose wallpaper, baseboards and partitions. Bed bugs can also be spread in clothing, baggage, secondhand furniture, bedding and laundry.
