

Organizations Approved to Bypass Biostatistics Design Working Group (BDW)

In order to streamline our review process for Mount Sinai investigator-initiated interventional research protocols, we have developed criteria for a waiver of biostatistical review. If the investigator-initiated study has already undergone rigorous:

- · scientific peer review and
- biostatistical review by a recognized external statistical reviewer

then the protocol will qualify for a waiver of internal BDW review. This should help prevent redundancy, and hopefully result in a more timely and efficient review process.
