

## For Applicants to ABMGG Fellowship:

Thank you for your interest in the Icahn School of Medicine @ Mt. Sinai's Clinical Laboratory Fellowship Program in the Department of Genetics / Genomic Sciences;

We have completed recruitment for the 2017 – 2018 academic year. The program has a firm deadline of **September 30th** for completed submissions with a primary start date of July 1<sup>st</sup> of the following year (**e.g., you apply by 9/30/17 for a 7/1/18 start date**). In the meantime, you should review the information regarding our programs on the web page (link provided). Additionally, we have provided the link to the American Board of Medical Genetics & Genomics (ABMGG) which is our governing body, and there you will find the outline for requirements during training and criteria for eligibility to become Board certified.

All Doctoral transcripts should be sent directly from your accredited school. If an original is not available at the time of application, we will accept a copy but upon acceptance into the program you will be required to provide an original copy translated into English should it come from an International institution. Letters of reference should be sent directly to me via email or fax from the author and not be older than six months. Should you have any additional questions please do not hesitate to contact us.

**The process for selection is as follows:** The review committee evaluates all applications based on established criteria and number of applicants for any given year. This process usually takes until the end of the year. Beginning in Winter, the committee narrows down selected candidates to create a final list that will be contacted for interviews. ***DUE TO THE HIGH VOLUME OF APPLICATIONS, WE DO NOT CONTACT CANDIDATES UNLESS THEY ARE BEING CONSIDERED FOR INTERVIEW.***
