

My Visit to the **Seaver Center** A Social Story






The Seaver Center is at Mount Sinai in New York City. I am going to visit soon.



When I go to the Seaver Center I get to do many different activities. I get to explore new toys.




I get to look at pictures on screens and listen to sounds. Sometimes I wear a sticker on my forehead.




Sometimes I wear three stickers on the top of my head while I look at black and white patterns.





Other times I get to wear a whole cap of stickers while I listen to sounds. I also get to watch a favorite show while I sit and relax!




At every visit, I will meet with doctors who will be happy to see me!








At some visits, I might go to a different building where a nurse will draw blood from my arm.
