The Mount Sinai Real Estate Office will make an assignment offer to those eligible House Staff/ Residents / Fellows appearing on the list of incoming House Staff provided by the Office of Graduate Medical Education (GME).

SPECIAL RATES- These special rent rates that Mount Sinai Health System offers are available ONLY to physicians in approved training programs at MSBI and NYEEI of Mount Sinai, and may be changed and or revoked.

How the housing process works:

APPLICATION An on-line housing application has to be completed by a deadline. A link to the application is located at the GME website and is open to incoming trainees from approximately January through mid-April. The specific housing application opening date and submission deadline will be e-mailed to all incoming trainees by the GME Office.

APARTMENT ASSIGNMENT Applicants are assigned to available apartments in the order set by their occupancy group and the **MOUNT SINAI HEALTH SYSTEM LOTTERY.** The

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occupancy groups with a guarantee of housing are assigned first in the order set by the Lottery. Assignment offers are guaranteed and first made to **new, incoming Residents and Fellows** in the Category One ACGME-accredited programs listed below. Housing offers will begin to be e-mailed to applicants no later than April 21, 2023. Your decision will be due 2 (two) business days after receipt of the e-mailed offer.

GUARANTEE A housing assignment offer in MSBI owned housing is guaranteed to those new, incoming MSBI Interns, Residents and Fellows in the following MSBI programs and new, incoming NYEE residents in the merged program mentioned below:

Cardiovascular Disease; Preliminary Internal Medicine continuing with MSBI Neurology; Preliminary Internal Medicine continuing with MSH-NYEE Merged Ophthalmology

LOTTERY- Housing applications will be reviewed for completeness through the submission deadline. The lottery process will be done immediately after the application deadline. Real Estate processes applications first from Families then Married and Municipal Domestic Partnership Couples then Singles in the order set by the lottery number (#1 being the most advantageous). Only ONE (1) housing offer will be made based on the #1 preference indicated on the Housing Application. However, if not available, we will work down the applicant's list of preferences.

Note: The Lottery process assigns a random number to each applicant and the assignment process is reviewed by the Mount Sinai Health System REAL ESTATE AND GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION OFFICES.

LEASING Upon acceptance of the assigned apartment, you will be issued an Occupancy Agreement for the term of your training. The Agreement can be terminated upon 30-days advance notice. A fixed security deposit of \$500 regardless of apartment size is required and will be due shortly after move-in.

HOUSING CONTRACT- An e-mail from the DocuSign application will be sent to you following on-line acceptance of an assignment. Within 5 days after receipt of Your contract, it must be signed and returned electronically via Docusign. Your assignment will be cancelled and the apartment will be re-assigned to another applicant if the signed documents are not returned to us by the deadline. The required security deposit payment is due after you move into the apartment and upon request from the property manager. Payment must be made via an online portal that will be provided to you.

TRAINING PROGRAMS- A change of training program and or hospital pay site while in MSMW or MSBI housing may void the housing guarantee and result in a move-out notice.

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A Housing ASSIGNMENT OFFER will **BE BASED ON AVAILABILITY** in Mount Sinai West housing and **IS NOT GUARANTEED.** Assignment will be made through the **MOUNT SINAI HEALTH SYSTEM LOTTERY** at the rents above.

MOVE-IN- The date on which you can move into housing will be after you have satisfied the credentialing requirements of the Graduate Medical Education and Human Resources Departments, AND your apartment is vacant and prepared for you.

Occupancy Agreements for most graduates will terminate at the end of their academic program which is usually at the end of June and some in July. Advance notification is sent to vacating occupants since those apartments are to be prepared for the incoming applicants.

Vacated apartments are prepared for move-in by the new occupant within 5-days of being vacated by the departing occupant. The required security deposit of \$500.00 will be due for payment online after move-in and upon request for same from the property manager.

APARTMENT ASSIGNMENT Applicants are assigned to available apartments in the order set by their occupancy group and the **MOUNT SINAI HEALTH SYSTEM LOTTERY.** The occupancy group with a guarantee of housing is assigned first, in the order set by the Lottery. Assignment offers are first made to new, **incoming Interns, Residents and Fellows** in ACGME-accredited programs based at Mount Sinai Morningside, West, Beth Israel, Mount Sinai Hospital and New York Eye and Ear Infirmary of Mount Sinai. We begin to e-mail housing offers to applicants no later than April 21, 2023. Your decision will be due 2 (two) business days after receipt of the e-mailed offer.

GUARANTEE A housing assignment offer is guaranteed to those in a CIR position; a housing assignment offer BASED ON AVAILABILITY in a hospital owned building will be made to those who are not in a CIR position.

LOTTERY- Housing applications will be reviewed for completeness through the submission deadline. The lottery process will be done immediately after the application deadline. Real Estate processes applications first from Families then Married and Municipal Domestic Partnership Couples then Singles, in the order set by the lottery number (#1 being the most advantageous). Only ONE (1) housing offer will be made based on the #1 preference indicated on the Housing Application. However, if it is not available, we will work down the applicant's list of preferences.
