

Graduates remember to pack 'digital suitcase'

Access to Icahn Mount Sinai technology resource for May 2026 graduating students

Expected graduates are reminded to pack their "digital suitcase" before their degree is conferred on May 5th. Graduating students' information technology accounts will expire, so students should download and save files they want to keep. It is very important that graduating students prepare to take steps to protect and save any data they may want in the future, excluding all patient information as well as research data and materials which are intellectual property of Mount Sinai. ***Graduates who are transitioning to residency, postdoctoral fellowships or employment at Mount Sinai will receive new employee email accounts (@mountsinai.org or @mssm.edu). Student accounts will terminate by the dates stated below and cannot be used to execute the duties of a graduate's new role within MSHS. Speak to your new supervisor if you have questions about the status of your new employee email account.***

To prepare for the discontinuation of a graduate's accounts, students should:

- ✓ Export files from their Icahn Mount Sinai accounts, including files stored in Blackboard MyFiles, Google Drive, Microsoft OneDrive, Teams, and SharePoint. Move exported files to the external cloud solutions of their preference. ***ISMMS has not enabled Google Takeout, students must export individual email messages they wish to retain.***
- ✓ Save a PDF document or print a hard copy of the Empower Student Billing Detail Summary or Invoice from the student's Empower Self-Service Portal for their 2026 financial records.
- ✓ Transition to a personal email account as their primary email account. Export any Icahn student email data they wish to retain, including their stored contacts. If students use their school-provided email address (first.last@icahn.mssm.edu) to log into personal online/digital services, they need to transition those subscriptions or services to their personal email address immediately (i.e. Chase, AMEX, Netflix, Uber).
- ✓ Update contact information in Empower and SinaiCloud, including personal email address and new mailing address information, to ensure future receipt of important messages from the school (i.e. tax documents).

Here is a chart that highlights what will happen with specific IT services, including how long graduates will have access to them.

Blackboard	Active until June 30, 2026
Office 365 (OneDrive; Teams; SharePoint)	Active until June 30, 2026

Icahn Mount Sinai Library Databases	Active until June 30, 2026
Network ID	Active until June 30, 2026
Zoom	Active until June 30, 2026
MARC	Active until June 30, 2026
ChatGPT Edu	Active until June 30, 2026
SinaiCloud & SinaiCentral (if not also an employee of MSHS)	Active until June 30, 2026

All content left in a student's Gmail account, Blackboard MyFiles, Google Drive, Google Gemini, Microsoft OneDrive, Teams, ChatGPT Edu, and SharePoint will be permanently deleted 30 days after student account termination.
