Tuition, Fees (cont.)

Postaward (once NRSA award is given)

Predoctoral:

NIH will pay (of the combined tuition, fees)
60% of the total, up to \$16,000 for single
degree, \$21,000 for dual degree.

Postdoctoral

NIH will pay (of the combined tuition, fees)
60% of the total, up to \$4,500, \$16,000 for
formal degree.

Institutional Allowance(s) / Indirect Costs:

Individual NRSAs-Fellowships (includes health
insurance):

Predoctoral	\$4,200
Postdoctoral	\$7,850

Institutional NRSAs: 8% of Direct Costs with
the exception of tuition, fees, and equipment.

Direct Compensation:

Health Insurance:

Single: \$4,909 effective 7/1/14-6/30/15
(Student + 1 and Family are not covered by the
Graduate School unless the student started
attending ISMMS before Fall 2009)

Tuition:

To be determined based on available funds
after deducting the direct compensation and
health benefits. Any tuition charges that push
the total (direct compensation + health
insurance + tuition) beyond \$42,000 will be
waived for students that are on research
project grants.
