Awarding of Honorary Degree

Helena Hansen. You are a trailblazing physician-scientist, cultural anthropologist, author, speaker, and policy maker and an important voice in addressing the social determinants of the health of our population. Your work has helped clinicians and practitioners to develop an understanding that they must strive to understand and act upon the institutional, social, and cultural influences on their patients' health.

You are a joint-appointed Associate Professor of Anthropology and Psychiatry at New York University. You earned your undergraduate degree at Harvard and MD and PhD in cultural anthropology at Yale University's NIH-funded Medical Scientist Training Program. During graduate school, you completed fieldwork in Havana on Cuban AIDS policy, and in Puerto Rico on faith healing in evangelical Christian addiction ministries founded and run by self-identified ex-addicts. After graduate school, you completed a clinical residency in psychiatry at NYU Medical Center/Bellevue Hospital, during which you also undertook an ethnographic study of the introduction of new addiction pharmaceuticals. You examined the social and political implications of clinicians' efforts to establish addiction as a biomedical rather than moral or social condition, as well as the ways that neurochemical treatments may be re-inscribing hierarchies of ethnicity and race.

This work informed your current book project, *White Opioids*, along with a feature-length visual documentary based on this work, *Managing the Fix*, which debuted at the annual meeting of the American Psychiatric Association. Your work has been published in both clinical and social science journals ranging from the *Journal of the American Medical Association* and *New England Journal of Medicine* to *Social Science and Medicine* and *Medical Anthropology*. You are also the author of *Addicted to Christ: Remaking Men in Puerto Rican Pentecostal Drug Ministries*. You are currently leading a national movement that is advocating for the training of clinical practitioners to address social determinants of health, or "Structural Competency," which is the subject of your co-authored book *Structural Competency in Medicine and Mental Health: A Case-Based Approach to Treating the Social Determinants of Health*.

You are the recipient of the Robert Wood Johnson Health Policy Investigator Award, Kaiser Permanente Burche Minority Leadership Award, an NIH K01 Award, a Mellon Sawyer Seminar grant, the NYU Golden Dozen Teaching Award, and the American Association of Directors of Psychiatry Residency Training Model Curriculum Award.

Helena Hansen. You have dedicated your wide-ranging career to studying the intersections of social forces and medicine, identifying opportunities for improving health and greatly improving access to care for all. For your innovative work, which has deepened our understanding of the social forces that influence public health, it is a privilege to confer upon you the degree of Doctor of Science, *Honoris Causa*.

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN BIOMEDICAL DATA SCIENCE

The Master of Science in Biomedical Data Science (MSBDS) program at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai integrates training and education in various aspects of biomedical sciences with machine learning, computer systems, and big data analysis, as well as access to large electronic medical record-linked biomedical repositories. The Master of Science in Biostatistics program is designed to prepare students with strong backgrounds in mathematics for careers as data analysts and applied biostatisticians in the biomedical and translational sciences. The program is directed at students whose goal is to work as a biostatistician in a clinical, research, or industry setting; or as a stepping-stone to pursue a PhD in Biostatistics, Epidemiology, or Bioinformatics. The curriculum emphasizes strong quantitative training, critical thinking skills, and practical strategies for addressing complex challenges of novel, clinical and translational research.

Equipped with a comprehensive knowledge of both statistical theory and biomedical applications, graduates of the Master in Biostatistics Program are in high demand for roles in various settings including academic medical centers, the pharmaceutical industry, and the government sector in agencies such as Departments of Health, FDA, NIH, and CDC.

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN GENETIC COUNSELING

The Master of Science in Genetic Counseling is a two-year, full-time course of study designed to train future genetic counselors. Genetic counselors help people understand and adapt to the medical, psychological and familial implications of genetic and genomic contributions to disease.

Genetic counseling students complete coursework in basic and clinical sciences, medical genetics and genomics, genetic counseling, and bioethics. Supported by the Division of Medical Genetics and Genomics within the Department of Genetics and Genomic Sciences, our students gain hands-on experience working with patients to understand the impact of genetics and genomics in medicine. Additionally, each student completes a thesis to develop the critical thinking and clinical research skills required to academically contribute to the profession.

The integration of the academic and clinical disciplines within the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences, Icahn School of Medicine, and the Mount Sinai Health System provides our students unparalleled opportunities for didactic and clinical experiences to develop the medical, scientific, and psychosocial skills necessary to practice in this challenging and exciting field. Our graduates are uniquely qualified and highly recruited professionals in one of the fastest growing areas in healthcare.

The Genetic Counseling Program is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Genetic Counseling and our graduates are eligible to sit for the American Board of Genetic Counseling Certification examination.
