Our Priorities

Since 2022, Mount Sinai has partnered with Guyana's Ministry of Health and Hess Corporation to support a bold vision for improving access to high-quality care nationwide. Our priorities through 2030 include:

- World-Class Cancer Care: Establishing a national cancer center to provide comprehensive screening and treatment for breast, cervical, and prostate cancer
- Women's and Children's Health: Supporting a new national Women's and Children's Hospital to deliver high-quality care and meet international standards
- Community-Centered Care: Expanding access so everyone across Guyana can receive health screenings, primary care treatment, and support services
- Hospital Quality Improvement: Implementing a national program to improve health care quality, safety, and service delivery in all of Guyana's regional hospitals
- **Digital Health:** Supporting Guyana's first national electronic health records system, granting all Guyanese digital access to their essential health information
- Capacity Building: Supporting health care professionals in advancing workforce development, specialized training, and leadership capacity.
