IHER Faculty Position to Address Mental Health Equity – Assistant Professor

The Institute for Health Equity Research (IHER) is seeking investigators whose research focuses on mental health conditions which disproportionately impact the following NIH-designated populations that experience mental health disparities in the United States (e.g., Black/African Americans, Latinos/Hispanics, socioeconomic disadvantaged individuals, and sexual and gender minorities (SGMs). The successful candidate will be given a faculty appointment at the Assistant Professor level within the Department of Population Health Science and Policy.

The Mount Sinai Institute for Health Equity Research (IHER) brings together a multidisciplinary team of experts to address the longstanding disparities in health and health care that are pervasive in our country. IHER's mission to promote health equity with an anti-racist and intersectional lens has never been more critical.

The Mental Health Equity Research Group within IHER is led by Dr. Sidney Hankerson, who is a national leader in using principles of community-engaged research to reduce mental health inequities. Core values of the Mental Health Equity Research Group are: community, equity, rigor, and service. Investigators who demonstrate embodiment of these values through their prior research, education, and/or clinical experience will be prioritized.

Ideal candidates will demonstrate a commitment to health equity science, strong communication and leadership skills, and a passion for promoting diversity in research. Candidates should hold a doctoral degree (PhD, MD, DSW, EdD, etc.) and have relevant research experience, as well as a strong publication record. Evidence of external funding is desirable, but not required.
