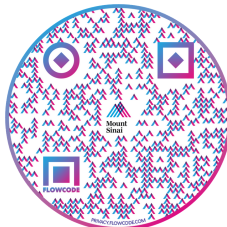


### MAKE AN IMPACT WITH YOUR GIFT
